Program Overview

Presentation

This 10-day immersive program introduces students to Athens as both an ancient and a contemporary city, where classical ideas coexist with modern urban life, creativity, social movements, and youth culture.

Rather than approaching antiquity as a static past, the program emphasizes continuity, transformation, and relevance, linking classical philosophy, democracy, and art to:

- modern European and global identities
- contemporary social issues
- creative expression and civic engagement

The methodology combines:

- short theoretical inputs
- experiential workshops
- city-based learning
- creative & reflective activities





Educational Rationale & Learning Objectives

Students will:

1. Understand the foundations of Western thought through direct engagement with Athens' historical landscape.
2. Explore how ancient ideas shape modern societies, politics, art, and public discourse.
3. Develop critical thinking and intercultural awareness.
4. Experience Athens as a living city, not an open-air museum.
5. Engage in collaborative, creative, and reflective learning processes.

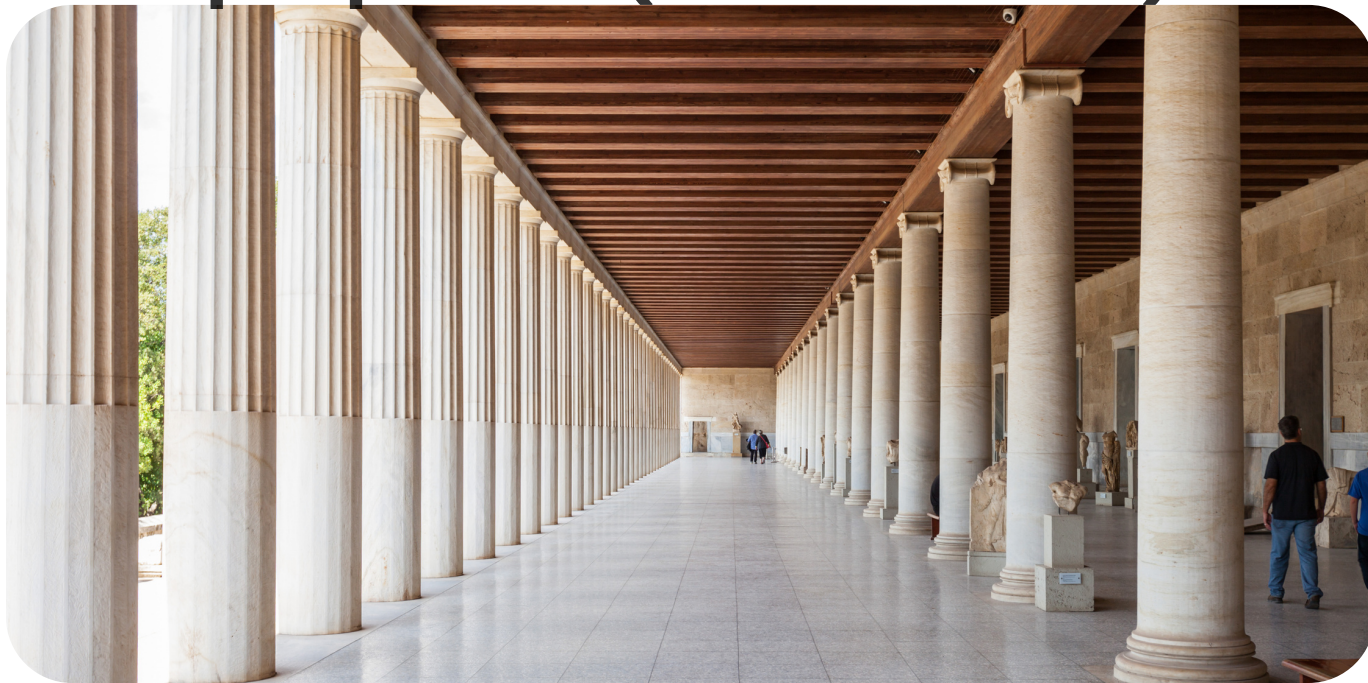
